Gists from the information text:

- Heroism was inseparably connected with the army
- War heroes = victim heroes → honourable death
 for the fatherland
- Ideals from a soldier: readiness to combat, courage,
 willingness to sacrifice, etc.
- Problem: The new form of a static warfare made

the heroic qualities useless
