1. Create a description and interpretation to the picture.

Some advices:

Picture description:

- Who or what exactly do you see on the picture?
- What does the persons clothing look like? What does it say about his status?
- What does the facial expression say? What does the gesture say? What does the attitude say?
- Is there a special background? Is there a connection between the person and the background?
- Are there any objects? What do they mean?

Picture interpretation:

- What does the title say about the picture? Is it simply describing the picture or does it help to interpret it?
- What did the picture mean to society at that time?
- What does the picture mean to society nowadays?
- What does the artist want to express with that picture?
- 2. Read the facts about the corresponding artist.
- 3. Compare and discuss your results in your team.
- 4. Create a presentation that represents the results of your group.

That presentation should include some information about the artist, the picture description and interpretation. It should not require longer than five minutes. Two to three persons are chosen to present.
